

**Draper City** has more than 60 miles of trails for cycling, hiking and horseback riding. The trails interconnect and can take you from town up into the foothills of the Wasatch Front. The city recently preserved more than 1,000 acres in Corner Canyon and partnered with Salt Lake County and Sandy City to set aside 2,000 acres along the Bonneville Shoreline Trail.

For those looking for a little shopping R&R, there is plenty of it in **Draper**, starting with IKEA's only intermountain store, located at the intersection of I-15 and Bangerter Highway. The store is a shopper's paradise for home design and household items – featuring more than 10,000 items. Located right across the street is Furniture Row. Many intriguing shops and restaurants are located at the 12300 South Exit from I-15. The Draper Peaks outdoor shopping center features a wide variety of unusual shopping experiences.

**Draper** is said to have one of the top locations in the country for hang gliding and paragliding. Gliders push off from the new Salt Lake County Hang Gliding Park, located at 15400 So. Steep Mountain Road (100 East).

For winter recreation, eight ski resorts are located within 30 miles. The closest resorts are a mere 20 miles up the Big or Little Cottonwood Canyons.

**DUCHESNE COUNTY**

In comparison to the rest of Utah, **Duchesne County** is relatively young. Homesteading did not begin in **Duchesne County** until 1905. It was first settled by fur trappers and the U.S. Cavalry and much later by Mormon settlers. Once the homesteading began small towns sprung up and still spread across the county. Most of the larger towns were started because it was a one day ride between them and that was where the travelers often stopped for the night. Today they are still the quaint small

towns one often sees in travel books with a grocery store and a small gas station.

**Duchesne County** has become Utah's little secret. Riddled with pristine lakes and meandering rivers and creeks through the Uintah's one can find almost any type of North American wildlife. **Duchesne County** is the Gateway to the High Uintah Wilderness for avid hikers, horseback riding and backpackers. Kings Peak, the highest peak in Utah is located in **Duchesne County** and surrounded by 100's of glacier carved lakes. One can view deer, antelope, beaver, moose, bears, and Golden Eagles, just to mention a few of the wildlife. Winter brings great opportunities for ice fishing, cross-country skiing and snowshoeing and snowmobiling. Anglers love to come to the area for the great summer fishing in a lake where they often find themselves alone or with just another angler or two.

The world's largest outdoor ancient art gallery is located primarily in **Duchesne County** in 9 Mile Canyon. Ancient petroglyphs and pictographs can be spotted all through the Canyon which has been a route for commerce for hundreds of years. With the help of a map that shows the spots to look for you can find traces of life going back hundreds of years.
